
## **NORMAL USE AND CARE:**

- · Dry blades completely after washing.

## **CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- **1.** Set pineapple corer on a towel near sink (to keep suction cups from sticking to sink surface).
- 2. Remove push-rod (5) from top of unit.
- 3. Push handle (2) ALL THE WAY DOWN until blades rest on base (1).
- Remove both quick-release pins (3), allowing peeling blade (4) to rest on base (1).
- **5.** Clean push-rod (5) and peeling blade (4) in **3-compartment sink** first:
  - a. Use one sink to wash parts in a detergent solution that is a minimum of 110°F.
    - Change solution regularly.
  - b. Use brush, cloth or nylon scrub pad to loosen particles.
  - c. Rinse parts thoroughly in a **second sink**. Ensure all food and detergent is completely removed.
  - d. Sanitize parts in a **third sink**, soaking in hot water or sanitizing solution.
  - e. Air-dry all parts on a rack.
- 6. Place the rest of the machine (without push-rod and peeling blade) in 3-compartment sink (place machine sideways to avoid suction cups sticking to the bottom of the sink):
  - a. Use one sink to wash machine in a detergent solution that is a minimum of 110°F. Change solution regularly.
  - b. Use brush, cloth or nylon scrub pad to loosen particles.
  - c. Rinse machine thoroughly in a second sink. Ensure all food and detergent is completely removed.
  - d. Sanitize machine in a **third sink**, soaking in hot water or sanitizing solution.
  - e. Air-dry machine with other parts.
- 7. Reassemble parts when dry.
